Welcome to the Sports Group of KZOW! You will have responsibilities pertaining to the Warrior Sports Network; providing for the commentators by doing boards for games, creating liners and content to go on the air, and possibly working your way up towards broadcasting games yourself! You will be taught all duties, and perhaps asked to cooperate with other groups. You will also be required to work live events at times you are available.

All students in the sports group will also be required to learn board and help broadcasters out during sporting events running board op. We will shoot for at least one broadcast a week and will let you know ahead of time on Monday Nights when a Board is needed.

Overview of practicum

We will meet weekly on Monday nights following Practicum. We will present the previous weeks assignments and go over what is due the next week. Examples for each assignment will be given. The first few meeting times will be learning and reviewing how the systems work and how to complete your assignments. All assignments must be completed and worked on. If examples were shown and guidelines given- those must be followed. Assignments will not be allowed if effort seems slack- you will have to recomplete by the next week for points. Tips and critiques will be given the following time we meet and any changes to those assignments will be given bonus points. Homework will be docked if turned in late and give a zero if never completed. There will be a chance of makeup work at the end only if needed or interested in extra points. Attendance and working Live Events are part of your grade so make sure to reach the total by the end of the semester. Students in this group will be asked to help other groups out along the semester when big projects come up. Practicum is a team effort and we all work together. The point of practicum is to give students real hands on experience and help learn a variety of communications skills. Directors and Managers want to help students find passion within the stations and are here to help.

Live Event Requirements

This semester, we’re changing things up a bit for KZOW students. We’re doing 5 live events, spanning over one per month, but students will also be required to participate in shows over the course of the semester.

- Shows
 - Required 5 total hours for 5 total shows (1 hour each)
 - Students/Directors may solo host, co-host, or guest appear on a show.
 - Any more shows or appearances may result in extra credit at director and manager’s discretion.
